# Can You Feel the Love?

I can hear Elton John crooning it now, "Can you feel the love tonight . . .?"

It is a month for lovers, and most people define love as a deep emotional feeling of affection, a warm, spontaneous 'cloud' which envelops and overtakes a person. It is as if it is irresistible. One cannot help it. We might even use words like "helplessly, hopelessly in love."

Can you feel it? Logic would say that if you are not feelin' it, you are not obligated to show it.

But, the Bible teaches us that God is love. His character essence is love. In fact, He is the Source of all love. How does that change our perspective?

Jesus said, "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you." (John 13:34). Can we "command" love?

Jesus came to reveal God to us. What does Jesus teach us about love? In Christ's birth, life, death, and resurrection, Jesus shows that love is ACTION! Love is sacrificial and serving others. He said nothing about "feelin' it." With Jesus, it was a conscious act of the will as He surrendered to His Father's plan. He even commanded us to love our enemies.

"Beloved, let's love one another, for love is

of God, and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. The one who does not love, does not know God, for God is love." (1 John 4:7ff).

Love is commanded. Love is a commitment of the will, of the heart. Many of us live in a covenant of love called marriage. God has given us families and friends to love.

Love is not a feeling, but an action propelled by the heart. It is sensitive to other's needs, self-giving to serve, willing to listen, compassionate, respectful, and faithful. These are not spontaneous, passionate feelings, but the volition of the will.

Love was a prominent description of the early, first century church, "Behold how they love one another!" Are we at Faith living like a first century church?

So, we are in the month for lovers. I confess to you that I often fail to love as Jesus asks. I turn to the Source, confessing my failure and asking forgiveness. Galatians 5 teaches us, "The fruit of the Spirit is love . . ." What I cannot do by my effort, the Spirit of Jesus does in and through me.

"Lord, fill us with your Holy Spirit so that we love one another and all those you bring into our lives. Empower us to love like Jesus."


