Gospel – Mark 5:21-36

²¹ When Jesus had again crossed over by boat to the other side of the lake, a large crowd gathered around Him while He was by the lake. ²² Then one of the synagogue leaders, named Jairus, came, and when he saw Jesus, he fell at His feet. ²³ He pleaded earnestly with Him, “My little daughter is dying. Please come and put Your hands on her so that she will be healed and live.” ²⁴ So Jesus went with him. A large crowd followed and pressed around Him. ²⁵ And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years. ²⁶ She had suffered a great deal under the care of many doctors and had spent all she had, yet instead of getting better she grew worse. ²⁷ When she heard about Jesus, she came up behind Him in the crowd and touched His cloak, ²⁸ because she thought, “If I just touch His clothes, I will be healed.” ²⁹ Immediately her bleeding stopped and she felt in her body that she was freed from her suffering. ³⁰ At once Jesus realized that power had gone out from Him. He turned around in the crowd and asked, “Who touched My clothes?” ³¹ “You see the people crowding against You,” His disciples answered, “and yet You can ask, ‘Who touched Me?’” ³² But Jesus kept looking around to see who had done it. ³³ Then the woman, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell at His feet and, trembling with fear, told Him the whole truth. ³⁴ He said to her, “Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering.” ³⁵ While Jesus was still speaking, some people came from the house of Jairus, the synagogue leader. “Your daughter is dead,” they said. “Why bother the Teacher anymore?” ³⁶ Overhearing what they said, Jesus told him, “Don’t be afraid; just believe.”
